



The Salvation Army Legacy Brass Band Membership Application

The Salvation Army Legacy Brass band was formed to provide an avenue of service and Christian fellowship for mature brass band musicians. The Band provides a resource to Salvation Army centres and churches in and around Eastern Ontario, particularly when regular corps bands cannot be available. The Band is a fellowship of Salvationists and members of other Christian churches in the community. In keeping with Orders and Regulations for Music Organizations in the Canada and Bermuda Territory (1999), Legacy Brass exists to proclaim the Army's message:

"Salvation from sin through Jesus Christ, and to accomplish the Army's purpose: the glorification of God and the salvation of souls."

Membership in the band is open to mature adult musicians who meet one of the following criteria;

- Salvation Army retired band member;
- Salvation Army active band member;
- Soldier or Adherent of The Salvation Army;
- Member of other Christian Churches and/or Denominations.

Membership of any member is subject to termination for;

1. Conduct that brings disrepute to the Band or The Salvation Army
2. Failure to fulfill reasonable musical responsibilities to the Band to the best of one's abilities.
3. Conduct disruptive to or damaging to the spirit of the Band, or its operations.

Applicants must accept the terms of the Constitution and the Mission Statement of the Band as a condition of joining the Band. Your signature below indicates your acceptance of the terms and conditions set out above.

Legacy Brass Band Privacy of Information Statement

Collection of information

The Executive Management Board of Legacy Brass may collect contact information from its members for purposes of operating the band's programs and activities. Only information required for the purposes of the band's regular operations will be requested. This may include, but not limited to, phone numbers, home or business addresses, email addresses, and any other information that may be required from time to time for the effective operation of the Legacy Brass Band.

Protection of information

The Executive Management Board of Legacy Brass will make all reasonable efforts to safe guard and protect information gathered by the Board.

Use of information

The Executive Management Board of Legacy Brass Band will only use such information for Legacy Brass Band purposes. Neither the Executive Board as a group, nor individual members of the Executive Board will use any of this information for any purpose other than those which may reasonably considered to be related to the Legacy Brass Band's operations.

Release of Information

Other than for those purposes which may reasonably considered to be related to the Legacy Brass Band's operations, the Executive Board will not release to any third party or organization a member's information without written authorization from the member or members as the case may be.

Duties of members

Any Band member acquiring other member's personal information in the normal course of band operations and communications is equally bound by this policy as if they were a member of the Executive Board of Management of Legacy Brass.
